## **GP and GP Out-of-hours**

- → Your GP is available from 8am to 6.30pm weekdays with same day appointments available if necessary

### Gare at the Chemist

Free fast expert health advice at your local pharmacy



For a wide range of everyday illnesses and ailments, Care at the Chemist is the quickest and easiest way to get treatment and expert advice from a health professional.

#### How does Care at the Chemist work?

The scheme is available to everyone who is registered with a Sefton GP.

- 1. You will need to visit your pharmacy in person, so that the pharmacist can fully assess your condition - most pharmacies have a private consultation room for this
- 2. On your first visit you will be asked to register with the scheme, so you will need to take proof of your name and address such as a utility bill, driving licence or credit / debit card
- 3. When you have been assessed you will be given advice on how to deal with your symptoms and any medication if you need it
- 4. Sometimes you may still need to see a doctor and if this is the case the pharmacist will let you know
